The two Highest placed exhibits not already qualified within the first six places will receive a “Registration of Qualification” Certificate in the ring

This Show is a qualifier for the 2008 BSPS Championship Show, to be held at Arena UK. The 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize winners in Classes 263 and 264, the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in classes 266 & 267 and 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> prize winners in classes 268 and 269 will qualify, provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rule 23 and 28 and ridden by B.S.P.S. Members. **B.S.P.S. No. 108/08**

Classes 263, 264, 266, 267, 268 and 269 are also qualifiers for the B.S.P.S. Travel Trust Association Challenge. The qualification will be awarded to the highest placed pony that has not qualified for the BSPS 2008 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class. If the highest placed pony has already qualified, the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony.

Classes 263, 264, 266, 267, 268 and 269 inclusive are qualifiers for the B.S.P.S. Premier League Competition. The qualification will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed ponies.

**B.S.P.S. Harry Hall Best Rider.** The best rider in each of the following Open classes at all B.S.P.S. Affiliated Shows will be awarded a best rider card and qualify for the final at the Summer Championships Show:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Lead Rein Hunter Type, 128, 138 & 148 Show Pony, 122, 133, 143 & 153 S.H.P., Cradle Stakes, Nursery Stakes, 133, 143 & 153 W.H.P., Intermediate SRT, SH & WH classes and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden and to the best rider 25 years and under in the Heritage Ridden and WHP classes.

This Show is a qualifier for the N.C.P.A. Pony of the Year Show and the Part Bred Welsh Ridden Championships to be held in conjunction with the Pony of the Year Show at Somerford Park, Congleton, Cheshire on 7<sup>th</sup> September 2008. First and Second Prize winners in appropriate classes

will qualify and highest placed not qualified in the first six for Part Bred Welsh in appropriate classes.

**N.C.P.A.No. 157/08**

**NPS Mountain & Moorland Qualifying Rounds:** The classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breeds are not eligible. Ponies to be trimmed only within their Breed Society specification. Manes must not be plaited and tails must not be braided.

Qualifying rounds are open to both NPS Members and Non Members, but only the highest placed NPS Adult member, on production of their membership card in the ring, will be eligible to qualify for the Final. A valid Membership Card must in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring.

The first prize winners from each class will go forward to the Final to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show, Malvern in August. A pony may only qualify once. Where the first pony in the class has already qualified the pony standing next in line, which has not qualified will be deemed the qualifier. Qualification may go no lower than third place.

NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the Final.

Qualified ponies must be entered into the NPS Competition Final within 14 days for the pony to be eligible to appear in the Final.

**NPS Mountain & Moorland In Hand Kilmannan Stud Silver Medal Rosette Championship**

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by The National Pony Society for the best registered pony in the Mountain and Moorland in hand section. The Sponsor's Rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving the Qualification Card (See NPS Silver Medal Championship Conditions in this schedule).

**NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championship**

These Championships are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded where the Owner of the champion pony is a Member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced in the ring. If the Owner of the Champion pony is not a Member, or the Owner's membership card cannot be produced in the ring, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided the Owner is a Member of the NPS and the membership card is produced in the ring. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the Qualification Card can only be awarded to the Champion or Reserve Champion.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show in August 2009, providing they send to the NPS Secretariat the relevant entry fee and qualification card.

The Show is a Qualifier for the BLUE CHIP & IDHS (GB) £2,000 CHALLENGE. The highest placed horse (not already qualified) from classes 276 and 277 will qualify for the Final of the Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) Championship, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show NB. A horse may only qualify for the Final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. Each qualifier will receive a rosette and £10 voucher from Blue Chip. IN THE FINAL, the champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money plus a Blue Chip rug. The Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, £100 prize money plus a Trophy will be awarded to the highest placed Pure Bred and a Trophy and £50 to the highest placed 15.2hh and under.
