## **EXHIBITOR PASSES**

Passes will be issued in relation to the number of entries made as follows (these will be in addition to members/patrons badges issued separately. Under 16years old will be entitled to free entry):

1 horse – 2 passes, 2 horses – 3 passes, 3 horses – 3 passes, 4 horses – 4 passes, 5 horses – 4 passes, 6 horses – 5 passes. Extra passes at £10/adult and £7/concessions may be purchased at time of entry. **PLEASE NOTE TICKETS WILL BE CHECKED ON ENTRY TO THE SHOWGROUND**

This Show is a qualifier for the P (UK) 2011 Winter Championships.

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each qualifying class will qualify. Competitors in qualifying positions, who are not current members of Ponies (UK) are allowed 14 days in which to become members and register their horses/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid.

No Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

This Show is a qualifier for the 2010 BSPS Championship Show, to be held at Arena UK. The 1st 2nd and 3rd prize winners in Classes 258 and 259, the 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 261 & 262 and 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prize winners in classes 263 and 264 will qualify, provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rule 23 and 28 and ridden by B.S.P.S. Members. B.S.P.S. No. 119/10

Classes 258, 259, 261, 262, 263 and 264 are qualifiers for the B.S.P.S. Classic Security (UK) Ltd Challenge The qualification will be awarded to the highest placed pony that has not qualified for the 2010 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the B.S.P.S. Challenge, the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony.

Classes 258, 259, 261, 262, 263 and 264 are qualifiers for the B.S.P.S. Premier League Competition. The qualification will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies.

B.S.P.S Black Country Saddles Best Rider of the Year. The best rider in each of the following Open classes at all B.S.P.S. Affiliated Shows will be awarded a best rider card and qualify for the final at the Summer Championships Show:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Lead Rein Hunter Type, 128, 138 & 148 Show Pony, 122, 133, 143 & 153 S.H.P., Cradle Stakes, Nursery Stakes, 133, 143 & 153 W.H.P., Intermediate SRT, SH & WH classes and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden and to the best rider 25 years and under in the Heritage Ridden and WHP classes.

This Show is a qualifier for the N.C.P.A. Pony of the Year Show and the Part Bred Welsh Ridden Championships to be held in conjunction with the Pony of the Year Show at Warren Farm Equestrian Centre, Formby, L37 0AN in September 2010. First and Second Prize winners in appropriate classes will qualify and highest placed not qualified in the first six for Part Bred Welsh in appropriate classes.

**N.C.P.A.No. 157/10**

**NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds:** These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show in August 2011

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the Final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. Judges and/or stewards are requested to check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes. NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the Final.

### **NPS Mountain & Moorland In Hand Kilmannan Stud Silver Medal Rosette Championship**

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by The National Pony Society for the best registered pony in the Mountain and Moorland in hand section. The Sponsor's Rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving the Qualification Card (See NPS Silver Medal Championship Conditions in this schedule).

### **NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championship**

To be judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the Owner of the champion pony is a Member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the Owner of the Champion pony is not a Member, or the Owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification Card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the Qualification Card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve. Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show in August 2011.
